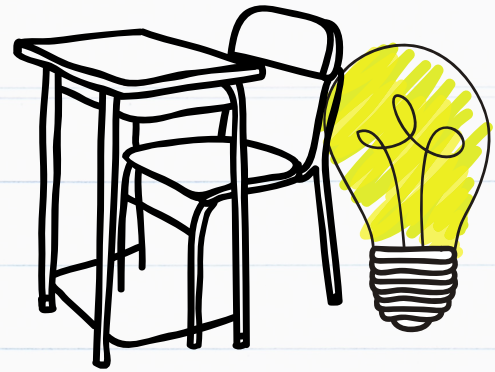

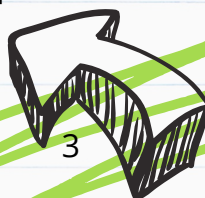
The course covers the history of Black, Indigenous and other People of Color (**BIPOC**) in the United States, beginning with pre-colonial history and ending with the Jim Crow era.

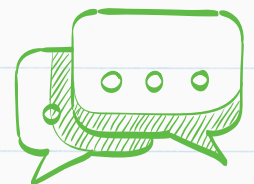
